	The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event which has insufficient entries. Minumum requirement is 3 entries per event. The Committee reserves the right to refuse or restrict entries without assigning any reason and to add to or alter these condititions. Its decision (s) on all matters shall be final
	Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the events for which they were entered.
	Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called.
	The seeding and the draw will be done by Badminton Ireland

Clothing / Advertising	For all semi finals and finals in this event it is mandatory to have your name on the back of your shirt. It is also mandatory that partners in doubles wear the same colour shirt and failure to comply will result in a €100 fine.

Entries	All 5 events will be played at the Championships in the following
	age groups: 35+/ 40+/ 45+/ 50+/ 55+/ 60+/ 65+/70+
	A player is eligible to compete, provided he or she fulfils the age
	requirements on 1st January of the year in which the Championships
	are played. Entries must contain the date of birth of each player.
	No late entries will be accepted.
	Singles: €30 per player
	Doubles: €20 per player
	All 3 Events: €60
	The entry fees must be paid at the same time as the entries are submitted. The entry fees will not be refunded in the event of a withdrawal.
	In the case that the entry fees have not been received before the event then players will not be allowed to play at the tournament. Payment must be done before their first scheduled match, failure to do so means that they will not be allowed to play.
	This rule will be enforced – no exceptions
	Entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the players withdrawing, the Organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member Association.  If a player/pair is listed on a "Waiting List", no entry fee is to be paid before being promoted to the Main Draw or Qualification draw.
	Organisers are allowed to refuse entries if players have outstanding fees from a previous year.
Withdrawals	No refunds will be considered if withdrawal is notified later than 10 days before the commencement of the Open. Players Associations will be responsible for any upaid fees.

Visas	After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member Association's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. It is the Member Association's responsibility to make sure that visa applications are made early enough.
	The Tournament Organisers will do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa.

Regulations	1. No player shall be eligible to compete unless he or she is in good standing with his or her national association.
	2. The Championships will be conducted under the rules of the Badminton World Federation and Badminton Ireland including the prohibition of doping for which tests may be carried out. Clothing and advertising must conform to the Badminton World Federation Regulations.
	3. No pair will be accepted unless entry forms and fees have been received from both players. The committee will do its best to find partners for any competitors if they are unable to find their own, but no guarantee can be given. Any competitor who is without a partner for any event and desires to be included in that event should write "partner wanted" in the appropriate place on the entry form.
	4. A player may play in a lower age group, but not a higher one, than his/her own age group. However, players may only enter 3 events (not necessarily in the same class), but a player may not enter more than one singles event.
	5. Players must be affiliated to Badminton Ireland or to another Member Association of the BWF to be eligible to enter. Entries will be subject to approval by the Tournament Committee.

6. The committee reserves the right to cancel any event which has insufficient entries. Minimum requirement is 3 entries per event. 7. The committee reserves the right to refuse or restrict entries without assigning any reason and to add to or alter these conditions. Its decision on all matters shall be final. 8. Rally point scoring will be used. All matches shall be the best of three games to 21. An interval not exceeding sixty seconds shall be permitted when a player/pair reaches eleven points in any game. An interval not exceeding two minutes shall be allowed between games. 9. Cheques should be posted to Badminton Ireland, National Sports Campus, Blanchardstown, Dublin 15, Ireland accompanied by the appropriate remittance for entry and should arrive no later than TUESDAY 8th April 2014. 10. Cheques should be made payable to BADMINTON IRELAND. 11. Late entries and entries sent without the appropriate entry fees are unlikely to be accepted. Late entries may only be accepted at the discretion of the tournament director with a late fee of €5.00.
