Competition	singles: single knock-out system in all rounds and match for third place. doubles: In the first round, groups of 3 or 4 doubles play against each other on each group. Only the group winner qualifies to thefollowinground. If the number of groups is greater than 2, the top two pairs qualify to the following round played on knock-out basis. There will be a match for the 3rd place.

	 If only one entry is registered to a specific age group event, the registration payment for the referred event will be returned if it has been already payed or the athlete/pair is eligible to play at same event in the age group immediately below, should he/she/they (is) are interested in. If only two athletes/pair register at a specific age group event, the champion will be decided in just one match. 		
	 For only three entries at a specific age group event, the one-against-all format applies. The athlete/pair with the largest number of victories will be 		



















the decision criteria. In case of a tie, the following criteria apply:

- Number of wins;
- Difference of games: difference of the total of game wins and game losses. The largest the difference the highest the score;
- Difference of points difference of the total of win and lost points. The largest the difference the highest the score;
- Direct match if the tie persists, the winner of the direct match gets the highest score;
- Random selection

Clothing
